The many subjects covered here—from beachcombing to classifying shells—are held together by a common thread—the author's great love for the barrier islands of the western Gulf of Mexico. Although not educated primarily as a biologist, Miss Andrews has devoted much of her postgraduate study to science. What counted in the compilation of material and ideas in this book was not, however, Miss Andrew's courses in biology, but her strong determination to find out about things not normally taught in formal courses and to get the necessary "words of wisdom" directly from authoritative sources. She has consulted the experts and utilized her information in a systematic way. Miss Andrews is a resident of Corpus Christi, where she teaches at W. B Ray High School.
